Media	Any person who wishes to photograph the event should apply for accreditation by completing Form 2 and returning to the Organiser before 7th March 2010

Competition Mode	<p>Compound Knockout will be used in categories where there are more than 8 players. In categories where there are 8 players or less, pools and knock out will be used. The Tournament Director reserves the right to amalgamate categories where there are insufficient entries.</p>
Event Eligibility	<p>This event is open to all school children who are members of the Irish Judo Association and or the Northern Irish Judo Federation. School children who hold valid membership of an Association or Federation recognised by the Irish Judo Association will also be accepted. In such cases evidence of insurance must also be produced. Where evidence of membership is not available the participant will be required to take out membership and insurance with the IJA. The 1st and 2nd placed competitor is entitled to attend at the National School's event which will be held in Finglas on the 27th March 2010.</p> <p>A school child is any competitor who is attending primary or secondary school and does not include those attending Technical Colleges or Colleges of Further Education.</p> <p>It is the responsibility of the organiser to forward competition sheets together with half of the total entry fees received to the IJA by Tuesday the 16th March 2010. The Irish Judo Association will compile the provincial results and post on the website.</p>

Judogi & Judogi Control	<p>The competition will be held in white and blue judogi and in line with the rules as set down by the IJF and EJU. Where a competitor elects to wear a blue judogi, he/ she must also have a white judogi available to conform with the rules.</p> <p>The women must wear a white non-transparent t-shirt. The bras must not have any hard pieces. Long hair must be tied up with the appropriate elastic band. Make up and jewellery are prohibited. Nails should be cut short</p> <p>The judogi control will be performed by the referees</p>
Insurance	<p>Each national federation/ club is responsible for insuring its competitors against injury and third party risk during the relevant period. The Irish Judo Association will not accept any liability for any loss or damage howsoever arising.</p>
Membership	<p>Evidence of membership with the Irish Judo Association and/ or the Northern Irish Judo Association and such other Federation as is recognised by the IJF/ EJU must be produced on check-in. Any person not providing evidence of membership will be required to take out membership of the IJA prior to competing.</p>
All-Ireland School Championships	<p>This event will take place on the 27th March 2010 commencing at 11.00a.m. Competition mode will be double knockout. Players will be required to weigh-in but an allowance of 1kgs will be allowed for men and 1.1kgs for women. Weigh-in and check-in will be from 9.30 -10.30</p>

Saturday 13th March 2010	<p>Weigh In for all competitors, Time: 18.00 -20.00 Venue:</p> <p>As this will be an open weigh-in all male competitors are required to present themselves for weigh-in in judogi pants where an allowance of 0.5kgs will be given. All female players are required to present themselves for weigh-in in judogi pants and t-shirt where an allowance of 0.6kgs will be given</p>
Sunday 14th March 2010	<p>Weigh in for all competitors, Time: 9.00 – 10.00 Venue: Competition commences at 10.30 a.m.</p> <p>Medals will be presented to those who are placed 1st and 2nd and 3rd only and will take place after each category</p> <p>All medal winners are to wear judogis</p>
