



Re: Referee Expenses.

Dear Fellow Judoka,

The payment of referees, which has been a burden to all referees, officials and contest organisers, has been confirmed and the following are the current guidelines.

The Irish Judo Association will cover the meal allowance and overnight stay at set rates, which can be claimed direct from the IJA.

The rates are as follows

Overnight stay (1 overnight stay only)	€50.00 (Maximum).
(This will be facilitated to officials who travel more than 250 Kilo-meters return trip)	
Evening Meal (1 evening meal only)	€20.00 (Maximum)

Note: This rate is based on the referee being in attendance for the entire duration of the competition.

A pro-rata system will be applied to referees who do not participate for the entire duration of the competition. This will be at the discretion of the Referee Committee.

The procedure to claim the allowances will be to complete a claim sheet which will be issued at the start of the day and when completed will be countersigned by either of the two signatures below.

The form will then be sent to the IJA who will process same and issue payment of a cheque by post.

Mileage will be based on the AA Route Finder and the rate will be €0.20/Mile.

This will be covered by the club/council organising the event.

This will be the maximum and if any official travels via alternative transport at a lower cost that cost will be covered.

Any officials utilising a car pool the expenses will be based on the vehicle as opposed to the quantity of the officials travelling.

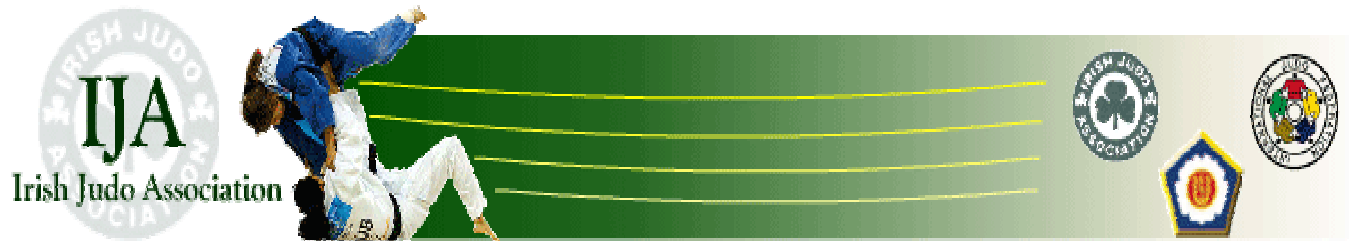
There will be national events, which will be under the supervision of the IJA and do not fall under the above scheme.
